A unique Sixth Form experience

Follow your passions and interests with invaluable experiences for personal growth, cultural enhancement, community involvement and leadership development. With learning experiences that extend beyond the classroom, here are some examples of what we have on offer:

- Community outreach work: volunteering, charity work and fundraising events
- Debating opportunities through Model United Nations and Debate Mate
- Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme (Silver and Gold) and National Citizen Service
 - Clubs, including Art, chess, climate change, cultural exchange, Drama, fitness, Geography society, mindfulness; Spanish cinema, table tennis and wellbeing
- Cultural trips, including museums, art galleries and landmarks
- Outward bound residentials and field trips including opportunities for global travel, with visits and expeditions abroad

Preparing students for the world of work

You will receive exemplary careers and higher education advice through a dedicated careers advisor who will arrange workshops, seminars, speakers, Careers Week and events for you and your parents.

- Experience the world of work through a one-week work placement within an organisation that fits with your individual aspirations and interests
 - Employment seminars: activities include mock interviews and guidance on writing exceptional CVs
 - Flying Start Degree Programme with PriceWaterhouseCoopers
 - Visits from former students and inspirational speakers with real life experiences of the world of work and university life
 - Careers Week, including guest speakers from key professions: Accountancy, Law, Medicine, Investment Banking
 - Guidance on how to search and apply for apprenticeships and attendance at National Apprenticeship Week to engage with a range of employers from various industries

University pathway

We offer personalised support in selecting degree programmes, at the broadest range of UK universities, and completing your UCAS application. In addition, we have various visits, day experiences, including university visits and guest speakers from institutions held at Bishop Douglass, and summer placements on offer alongside interview and exam preparation for those wishing to apply to Oxbridge or Medicine.

- Taster and open days at a wide range of universities, including Russell Group and Oxbridge
- Invitations to summer school programmes held at universities during the summer break; hearing from inspirational speakers; personal statement workshops; mock interview practise and student finance guidance
 - A virtual university course: attend lectures, seminars and tutorials which mirrors university study
- Entrance exam preparation, including Medicine and Oxbridge interviews
 - Support with UCAS application writing from our experienced team of staff

Essential skills

Nurturing your ambition, boosting resilience, developing leadership and team building skills to ensure that your personal development and wellbeing are a priority. We will concentrate on developing your self-confidence, community awareness, self-esteem and transferable skills as part of building your portfolio of work and personal life attributes.

- A range of senior leadership and peer mentoring roles are available: Head Boy/Girl; Deputy Head Boy/Girl; Senior Prefect for Peer Mentoring and New Starters; the Charity Events Committee and Common Room Committee
 - Student-led programmes, including involvement in our Student Council and creating and running clubs for younger students
- An enhanced Leadership Programme where sixth formers learn to become leaders in their chosen field
- Study and Entrepreneurial Life Skills Programme
 - Support with CV writing and job interview preparation





Moving into Year 12

We understand that the leap into Sixth Form education is not an easy one but we are here every step of the way. Expectations on students are higher, you will be required to work independently, and there is pressure to juggle this with extensive extra-curricular activities.
